

Official Race Registration Requirements 2021 SCORE International Race Season


You must read and understand the requirements in this document prior to applying for a race.

The requirements are new for 2021.

This document outlines the requirements for registering your team for a race. Step by Step procedures on how to use our online system is an additional document and is highly recommended to review if you are a first-time user of our online system. You will need the Schedule of Events to follow along with deadline requirements. Race participants are required to read and understand the SCORE rulebook and all race event specific published information.

FIRST STEP - MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENT: All race participants must purchase a 2021 SCORE Membership online. All race participants must have a current membership prior to registering for a race and must complete race registration to be listed on any SCORE publication including the SCORE Journal, Race Program, and on the Entry List. Memberships are valid for one calendar year (Jan 1st-Dec 31st, 2021) at an online cost of \$75 and is non-refundable and non-transferable. Memberships purchased at on-site registration will be \$100.

New for 2021: 2021 SCORE Membership cards are now digital and are sent via email to the purchaser, along with your payment confirmation email (see sample of email below). The SCORE Membership Card is available for online purchases only. Memberships purchased at the race or in the SCORE Ensenada Office Membership will not receive a Membership Card. Valid email is required.



Those purchasing multiple SCORE Memberships will receive an email with the link to all virtual cards. You will have to send each virtual card to the individual and the easy directions on how to do that is in the Step-by-Step Online Tutorial document under SCORE Membership.

IMPORTANT: Membership is NOT a race registration. Anyone can purchase a SCORE Membership fans and racers alike, yet all racers have to be current SCORE Members in order to race.

PLEASE NOTE: You will be required to bring a receipt for any balance due payments or 2021 SCORE Membership purchases made <u>after the online race application deadline</u> as the SCORE team may not have internet access in Mexico. Proof of payment is your responsibility, so you are advised to save your receipt any way possible. Without proof of payment or verification, you may be charged again in order to for you to be banded.

Step 2: Acquire a SCORE approved vehicle/moto/quad number. Have your SCORE assigned race number prior to registering for a race. Contact 702-407-3059 if you need a race number assigned to you or to verify a past number used.

Step 3: The Driver, Rider, or Alternate of Record Race Entry application. Be advised of the following:

- To register for a race: Since the system recognizes your Membership purchase through your log-in information, to complete an Official Race Entry application for the DOR/ROR will need to use the same log-in information (Username & Password) you did for the purchase of the 2021 SCORE Membership. If you do not use the same log-in the system will delete the race registration information you just entered at check out. If this happens contact the Registration Office 775-852-8907.
- Listing your Sponsors. Type in your lists horizontally (like a paragraph) as our system only supports typed lists. You cannot copy in a list from another source. Use upper and lower case, spaces, and commas in between. The way you enter your sponsors will be the way it shows on the entry list and in the journal. Do not use all CAPS. If BFG is your sponsor, please type it as BFGoodrich Tires. Fox Shox, Monster Energy, and others prefer full names instead of abbreviations, or acronyms. Remember, your sponsors are looking at the list too.
- Listing Co-driver, Co-riders, and Navigators names: You must keep this list updated when the co-drivers/co-riders/navigators change as the names registering as co-drivers/co-riders/navigators for the race must match those listed by the Driver or Rider of Record in order for them to be banded. This list is for verification purposes only and aimed to protect team from imposing "racers".
 IMPORTANT: Listing names on the race application does NOT register your co-drivers/co-riders/navigators for the race. They have a separate race application form to complete, in addition to having purchased a current SCORE Membership online. In order to be registered for a race or be listed on any SCORE publication they must meet these requirements; see Step 5 for further details on Co-driver/Co-rider/Navigator Required Race Application. Race Participants you have on your team that are under the age of 16 and/or without a driver's license, their parent or guardian must contact SCORE Office to register 775-852-8907. It is the DOR/ROR/ALT responsibility to make sure the entire team gets fully registered.
- Have your Sport Tag transponder number available: The transponder mounted on your race vehicle/moto/quad must match the number that is entered on your application. If you already have a transponder, your team must bring verification of the transponder number (located under the bar code) in order to pick up the Racer Packet at on-site Race Registration on race week. The easiest method of verification is with your camera phone. If you do not have one, answer "No, I do not have one" and "I want to buy a transponder" and the system will automatically charge you for one. The cost is \$100. Transponder online purchases are to be picked up at on-site race registration on race week.

Step 4: New Requirements for Paying for the event. When completing an online race application, a deposit is allowed and is applied towards your entry fee. Full payment is required for your entry in order to retain any earned start positions. All other teams who did not race the previous race that have made full payment by the deadline will qualify to be entered into the draw. You may need to contact your bank for an extension of your credit limit to allow the full amount of the entry fee <u>prior</u> to registration. We do not allow extended registration time for credit limit errors. If a deposit is made upon entry the remainder of the balance is due on or before the day online registration ends. In the event of a withdraw SCORE will retain the deposit (See Refund Policy below for more details). Walk-in Registrations in the Ensenada SCORE Office must pay entry <u>in full</u> at the time of registration, and the participants must have purchased a 2021 SCORE Membership online prior to registering for a race.

IMPORTANT: Any team that signs up AFTER the posted online race application deadline, will not be in any SCORE publication including the Final Entry List. Full payment of entry is required to be included in the draw or qualifying by the online application deadline posted in the Schedule of Events. Any entry fee paid on race week is \$200 USD more for late fee the 54th Baja 1000. Team members cannot be banded to race until the entry is paid in full. If Add Driver insurance fee is due for Codrivers/Riders/Navigators exceeding 5 on a team, the Driver or Rider of Record must pay this fee prior to receiving his/her band. See Schedule of Events for deadline details.

We do not accept checks. Wire transfers must be completed by the online application deadline, so submission of a wire payment must be made three days prior the day of this deadline. Contact the Registration Director for wiring information registration@score-international.com.

Step 5: Co-Drivers/Co-Riders/Navigators Required Race Application. All Co-drivers/Co-riders/Navigators on a team *are required to complete separate a race Application form* that differs from the Driver, Rider, Alt of Record applications. This must be completed for them to race, to be covered by the SCORE Insurance, and to be listed on the Entry List or any SCORE publication. They must have purchased their 2021 SCORE Membership online prior to completing their race application. To access this application, go to www.score-international.com > Race Info > Registration > Select "Co-driver, Co-rider and Navigator Race Application for the 54th Baja 1000". Navigators under the age of 16 years old or any racer without a valid government issued driver's license must contact SCORE Registration Office at 775-852-8907. To co-drive a four-wheel vehicle or co-ride a moto/quad possess a valid, government issued, non-restrictive driver's license. Copy of Minor's license MUST BE provided prior to application. Minors will need Parental/Legal Guardian to complete a Consent Waiver, and be present at Registration Check-In. See *Minor Policy* for further details.

Step 6: Onsite Team Check-in at the race: All participants must check-in on time at the on-site racer registration and complete all registration requirements not done online to be banded to race (See **Schedule of Events** for Registration location, times and dates). All racers on the team must have checked-in and have completed all registration requirements by the scheduled deadline. Late Entries (walk-ins) will not be accepted after 3 PM on Tech & Contingency Days.

Check-ins after registration closes are not accepted, and registration (getting banded) is not permitted on race-days (see WARNING below) If any participant feels they cannot personally show at registration check-in and is over the age of 18 with a valid Driver's License, they must complete all of the steps of submitting a Notarized Waiver Tutorial. All Registration requirements must be completed prior to waiver submission. Those in Stock UTV Classes must also submit a notarized "Stock UTV Class Participant Addendum" with the notarized race participant waiver. All waivers submitted must be the version with the revision date of 03.01.21 to be accepted.

WARNING: If a team member does not make it to on-site race registration to be banded, or previously submit a notarized waiver (version with revision date of 03.01.21), she/he will not be allowed to race. If the registered Driver or Rider of Record does not show up to be banded by the deadline of on-site Racer Registration nor submit a Notarized Waiver, the entry will be pulled from the race and be subject to no show/late withdrawal fees.

Step 7: Submit signed waivers for any Controlled Access Bands for Team Essential and Support Members: Bands must be picked up at on-site Registration at the race prior to closing (see Schedule of Events). Controlled Access Waivers do not need to be notarized but MUST have original signatures in order to receive bands for those members. Minors must have Parent/Guardian submit Minor Consent Waiver along with Controlled Access Waiver submitted, (see *Controlled Access Policy* for restrictions). All waivers submitted must be the version with the revision date of 03.01.21 to be accepted. Controlled Access Bands are not available for pick up on race days.

Refund policy: SCORE Memberships are **non-refundable** and **non-transferrable**. Add Co-driver/Co-rider/Navigator SCORE Insurance fees are non-refundable. Race entry refund requests made to the Registration Office within three days of submitting application will receive a full refund. Refund requests prior to the opening pre-running, SCORE can retain the deposit for incurred expenses. After pre-running opens, any requested refunds, non-starts, and no shows will be subject to late withdrawal fees that will include incurred expenses up to that point. If received wristbands by method of submitting a notarized waiver, all bands and parking stickers must be returned in order to start the refund process. Please submit refund requests to registration@score-international.com or contact via phone 775-852-8907.

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BE ADVISED:

- Any Driver or Record or Rider of Record with multiple entries in the same class will need special
 assistance with registration. You must contact the Registration Director at 775-852-8907/registration@score-international.com prior to filling out entry application.
- Up to five registered Co-drivers/Co-riders/Navigators with SCORE Memberships are permitted to register per team. For the 54th Baja 1000 teams may have two additional race participants. The Driver or Rider of Record will be required to pay additional insurance fees for the additional team members. These fees are non-refundable, even if the participant does not race.
- Racing on Multiple Teams: If co-driving/co-riding/navigating for multiple teams you will have to be banded for each team or a team could face penalties. In the question that asks for the vehicle/moto/quad race number put all race numbers of the teams you are on in one Co-driver/Co-rider/Navigator race application. Multiple race applications are not necessary. However, a DOR/ROR that is entered into the race but is also co-driving/co-riding/navigating on another team will need to submit a separate co-driver/co-rider/navigator race application to race on that other team.
- Even if you are in race gear government issued driver's license or ID is still required for banding.

By submitting this application for participation in the 34th San Felipe 250, 53rd Baja 500, 2nd Baja 400 or the 54th Baja 1000 you are acknowledging it is the responsibility of each race participant to read and thoroughly understand the Racer Brief, Penalty Bulletin, the 2021 SCORE Rule Book and all applicable waivers.

This is an extremely dangerous sport!
