

Controlled Access SCORE Baja 500 Tech Inspection & Start/Finish Areas



Access to designated locations

All persons eligible for access to the SCORE designated locations must register with SCORE, sign waivers, and receive SCORE Baja 500 wristbands. Persons that are not banded who do not follow SCORE Officials direction in these areas will result in persons being denied access and can result in 15-minute penalties to a registered team. Be respectful to all staff and volunteers.

In addition to banded race participants, each team may request wristbands for up to five (5) essential team persons. An essential team person is someone necessary to service or repair the race vehicle or is extremely important to the operation of the race team. Refer to Registration Access for information on how to obtain the essential team persons waiver forms and wristbands.

Registration Access

The on-site Registration area is limited to persons entering the race as a participant and up to five (5) essential team members. All must obtain a race weekend wristband in order to attend Tech days and have access to the Finish Area on race day. Essential team members who live in different areas, may submit multiple forms as long as they do not exceed a total of five (5). The DOR or Team Manager can bring the signed form to Registration or the essential team persons can come to Registration.

Essential team persons do not have to attend registration if they pre-sign the **Controlled Access Area** waiver form. Simply print this waiver form from the SCORE website, (select Race Info > Race logo > Waivers), and have up to five (5) persons sign this form. Bring these signed Controlled Access waiver forms to onsite Registration when you register to obtain bands.

All signatures **must be original**, you cannot have anyone sign for others. When you present the waiver form(s) to Registration, if any signature appears to not be original, you will not receive a wristband for that person.

All participants and essential team persons must sign waivers and be banded by the close of onsite registration, Friday, June 2nd at 4:00pm.

NO WRISTBANDS WILL BE AVAILBLE AT TECH OR SATURDAY AT THE FINISH LINE AREA

Controlled Access waiver forms are also available for pickup in the SCORE Ensenada office.

Tech/Contingency Access

Only banded race participants and banded essential team members will be permitted in the SCORE area on Tech Days. *No spectators will be allowed*. You must go to registration prior to placing your vehicle at the entrance to Tech. If your team has not been banded, you will be moved to the side and will not be allowed to enter Tech line until your registration is complete.

Start Area

All race vehicles must enter the starting area under their own power and starting Driver/Co-Drivers (Navigators), Rider or Co-Riders must be in or on the vehicle, safety equipment secure and be ready to go. Only the race vehicle and persons onboard will be permitted entry into the restricted start area... chase vehicles and additional team members must remain outside the fenced starting area.

Baja 500 Finish Area

Only banded race participants and up to five (5) essential team persons will be allowed in the finish area. Only the race participants can be on the interview ramp, all others must stay at the bottom of the ramp. (This means only DOR/Co-driver/Navigator, ROR/Co-Rider.) Essential team members may meet the team at the bottom of the ramp if they have race day wristbands.

SCORE Team Media

All registered and approved Team Media must attend onsite Media registration. There will be no SCORE Team Media credential requests accepted at race site as registration for credentials closed May 19th. Media access at the finish is limited to an area after the finish side of the interview ramp. Team Media is not allowed on the ramp at any time.

Review Results with Race Director

Only the Driver of Record/Rider of Record plus one other member will be permitted to meet with the Race Director to review results for your entry. See time and location on Schedule of Events
