La Paz, BCS, Mexico to Ensenada, BC

NOTE: Daylight Savings ends 2:00 am Sunday, Nov. 7

All times for Baja 1000 scheduled activities in La Paz will be noted MST (Mountain Standard Time). All other times will be PST (Pacific Standard Time) if activity is either online or occurring in Ensenada.

In an effort to assist race teams with registering and obtaining race day wristbands for individuals who will be going up course and or will not attend registration in La Paz, the SCORE Registration staff has developed several methods that will be available to you. To take advantage of these Registration options you must comply with all dates, times, deadlines, and information in this document.

Baja 1000 registration and signing of waivers for co-drivers/co-riders/navigators and Essential Team members will open on September 13th during Baja 400 week. Waiver forms for the November Baja 1000 and online registrations can be completed at the Baja 400 Registration. The Baja 1000 waivers are not your race registration. In addition to advance signing of Baja 1000 waivers, you must still register online for the Baja 1000. Registration for Drivers/Riders of Record will open September 25th online and in the Ensenada office.

If an individual signed waiver forms at the Baja 400 go to step b. If you did not submit a waiver at the race and want to utilize notarized waiver forms for the Baja 1000 you must follow all the steps below indicating if you will pick up the team bands in Ensenada office Nov 9 – 10th, or would like wristbands mailed to the team primary contact person:

- a) If you want to send in waiver forms and did not race the Baja 400, go to Score-international.com>Race Info>Registration Information>Notarized Waivers Procedure. Print the Participant and Controlled Access Waiver (used for Essential Team Members) forms and read the documentation on the Baja 400 menu for Tech Days/Start/Finish Wristbands and Requirements.
- b) Send Registration a prepaid return shipping label via email. Example: stamps.com. If you prefer to pay cash, call Registration. The cost will be \$10.
- c) Ensure the shipping address is correct as all team bands will be mailed to one address. You are responsible to distribute to your team members.
- d) If you have Essential team members needing bands for Tech Day, or Start/Finish area, you may email a Controlled Access waiver form along with the participant waivers forms and all bands for the team will be mailed to one person.

BAJA 1000 REGISTRATION DEADLINES - ALL TIMES ARE PST

October 16, 5pm PST

DEADLINE TO ENTER and be listed in the race program and SCORE Journal. Deadline for teams to submit notarized waivers if not planning on attending onsite Registration in La Paz ~~Nov. 13 – 15~~.

NOTE: One team member must come to onsite registration in La Paz to pick up your teams Driver Packet and distribute the information to all your team members. The information will also be posted on the SCORE website October 19th at 6pm.

NOTE: For teams wishing to submit notarized waiver forms for wristbands to be mailed or to have a team member pick up the wristbands in La Paz onsite Registration, the deadline is **5pm**

Registration Schedule - Continued

Monday, October 16. After this date, if notarized waivers were submitted and entry fees ARE NOT paid in full, and team paperwork is not correctly submitted, your bands will be in La Paz and must be picked up there. They will NOT be mailed or be in the Ensenada office. It is the DOR/ROR's responsibility to ensure all team members are registered, fees paid, and have wristbands before they get in or on a vehicle or moto/quad.

October 16, 5pm PST

If you submit notarized waivers forms and choose not to have your bands mailed, and fees are all paid and team paperwork complete, you may pick up wristbands in the SCORE Ensenada Office Nov. 9-10, from 9am to 4pm. Bands not picked up will be taken to La Paz and a team member will need to pickup and delivery to you. If you plan to attend Registration onsite, in La Paz, you do not need to submit notarized waivers.

All minors are required to come to La Paz Registration with a parent or a person with proof of legal guardianship. A picture I.D. for both persons will be required.

IMPORTANT: All persons in a race vehicle or on moto/quads must have a race weekend wristband on at all times or you are not eligible to race and your team could be disqualified and you will not be covered by the SCORE insurance.

October 30, 5pm PST

DEADLINE to apply online for race entries, pay entry fees or register in person in our Ensenada office to be on the Final Entry List. Teams who participated in the 4th SCORE Baja 400 Presented by VP Racing Fuel with registrations completed for the Baja 1000 and fees paid will be given their earned start position documented on the Baja 400 results. Failure to register by this date and time and have fees paid in full cancels the start position earned at the Baja 400. All other teams who complete an online registration or Ensenada registration with fees paid in full will be entered in the start position draw. (See 2023 SCORE in-Class Starting Order Policy for detailed draw information) Draw results will post 6pm Friday, November 3rd or before.

DEADLINE to REGISTER Co-Drivers/Co-Riders/Navigators

Must have memberships purchased and completed a race entry registration by this deadline to be on the Final Entry List used by Mexican Immigration authorities to allow entry into the county and to be covered by SCORE Insurance while pre-running. If Co-drivers/Co-riders/Navigators are not on the entry list this means they have not completed these two tasks, this means they **MUST** come to La Paz to complete registration, sign waivers, and receive wristbands. Remember, they cannot race without a membership, waivers signed, fees paid and being issued a race weekend wristband. They will NOT be able to pick up wristbands in the Ensenada office.

After close of online registration October 30th, late registration will continue at the SCORE Ensenada office through 5pm Nov 2nd. If you are registered and all the teams' fees are paid, and you are going to be up course, you may pick up your bands in the Ensenada office Nov. 9 and 10th between 9am and 4pm.

DEADLINE for Team Media Registrations.

All team media personnel planning to provide coverage for team use and social media posting must register by 5 p.m. PT on Oct. 30. You will be required to attend SCORE Media Registration either in La Paz Monday, November 13, Tuesday, November 14 and Wednesday, November 15 during onsite registration hours or you may go to Media Registration in Ensenada Wednesday, November 15th and Thursday, November 16th.

DEADLINE to Register Aircraft & Unmanned Aircraft Systems (DRONES)

You must submit an Aircraft Registration form, Certificate of Liability and Notarized Aircraft waiver form to: aircraft@score-international.com. There will be an Aircraft Pilot Meeting either via conference call or onsite in LaPaz.
