

# Class 1

**OPEN WHEEL – Unlimited**  
**Competition Numbers 100-199**

## DEFINITION

Unlimited four-wheel single and two-seat vehicles with unlimited displacement.  
Open wheel class. No production bodied vehicles or production appearing vehicles allowed in this class.  
Vehicle must be rear or mid-engine design with independent rear suspension (IRS).  
Minimum vehicle weight is 3,500 lbs. (1587.6 kg) Dry Weight  
Gasoline and diesel engines with unlimited displacement  
Engines may be either normally aspirated or forced induction.

## GENERAL REGULATIONS

Entrants in this class shall comply with all applicable general regulations.

## COMPETITION REGULATIONS

This class is an open production class and all components will be considered open unless restricted herein. Vehicles that raced SCORE previously, and do not meet current specifications, can possibly be modified and “Grandfathered” into current competition. Contact SCORE Tech Director for information.

## Class 1

### ENGINE, TRANSMISSION AND DRIVELINES

#### CR 23 ENGINE and ENGINE DISPLACEMENT

Unlimited number of cylinders and displacement

#### CR 24 ENGINE REPLACEMENT

#### CR 25 TRANSMISSION – Must be transaxle design

#### CR 26 THROTTLES

Forced induction is allowed for both gasoline and diesel engines.

Maximum of two (2) turbochargers allowed.

No restriction on engine displacement.

No restriction on turbo size.

No restriction on air intake size.

#### Cooling of the charge

Heat exchangers (intercoolers) must be of the air/air or air/water type.

#### For Diesel engines:

The diesel engine must be clean burning. Diesel engine smoke is strictly **PROHIBITED!**

Water injection is allowed.

Tools, spare tires, and parts must be removed, but otherwise the vehicle must be race ready including radio and fire extinguishers. Roll cage weight will be as raced, minus fuel, as the vehicle sits on the starting line. Official weight will be considered weight shown on official scales. Must present official scales weight certificate if requested.
