



## HOW TO ELECTRONICALLY SIGN WAIVERS AND RECEIVE YOUR WRIST BAND(S) WITHOUT ATTENDING ON-SITE REGISTRATION

To be eligible to submit Waiver(s) for wristbands to be mailed in the US or handed off to another team member, all race participants must complete their race application and purchase their membership **ONLINE**. Also, the Entry must be **paid in full** at the time of request, and their name must be listed on the DOR/ROR application (aka Official Race Entry). Detailed instructions are below. **If you have a scheduling conflict and cannot make Registration Check-In, these steps are important as there are no late check-ins permitted on race day.** The added benefit of completing all these steps is you can avoid long lines and wait times at on-site registration if completed prior to the mailing deadline (see schedule details below). Registration Check-In dates on Race Week are outlined below for the 2025 58<sup>th</sup> Baja 1000:

Nov 11	<b>Tuesday</b>	<b>9 AM – 5 PM</b> No walk-in entries after 4 PM	Mandatory Registration for ALL Classes
Nov 12	<b>Wednesday</b>	<b>8 AM – 5 PM</b> No walk-in entries after 4 PM	Mandatory Registration & Tech/Contingency for ALL Classes
Nov 13	<b>Thursday</b>	<b>8 AM – 4 PM</b>	Mandatory Registration & Tech/Contingency for ALL Classes <b>See Schedule of Events for times and further information on all requirements</b>
Nov 14	<b>Friday</b>		<b>RACE DAY!</b> Absolutely <b><u>NO</u></b> Registration or banding of any team member allowed on this day.

Below are the required steps for a **Driver / Rider of Record / Alternate, or Co-Driver / Co-Rider / Navigator** to receive wristband(s) in the mail:

1. Must have purchased a 2025 SCORE Membership online before submitting a race application, and/or Co-Driver / Co-Rider / Navigator application. ☐
2. Official Race Entry application completed, and all fees are **paid in full**. ☐
3. Complete Digital Waiver(s) online. Tutorials and shortcuts for waivers can be found at [www.SCORE-International.com](http://www.SCORE-International.com) > Race Info > Select the logo for the event you're racing, select waiver or tutorial to complete the Race Participant Waiver you need. ☐

4. **Once you have completed the online Waiver(s), 2025 Membership(s), DOR/ROR/Alternate entry forms, and the Co-Driver, Co-Rider, Navigator Application(s) send an email to [Registration@SCORE-International.com](mailto:Registration@SCORE-International.com) requesting wristbands. Please list all members you would like wristbands for. Only those who show completed online Waiver(s), 2025 Membership(s) DOR/ROR/Alternate entry forms, and the Co-Driver, Co-Rider, Navigator Application(s) will be eligible for wristbands to be mailed. Make sure to provide a mailing address for the bands. Once the email has been received, the following will be done:**
  - a) The DOR/ROR account will be billed \$10.00 for postage. One charge, one mailing per Team.
  - b) Once this fee has been paid the bands will be created and mailed out via USPS Priority mail, and a tracking number will be provided to you. Make sure to list all team member(s) wristbands requested, we will not mail out multiple sets.
  - c) For the ship to address, use the address you want the wristbands sent to. They will be mailed in one envelope.
  - d) If you request a Team Member to pick up your band(s) at onsite Racer Registration, you must advise us in writing. Picture ID will be required.
  - e) NO minor bands will be mailed or provided to any person other than the minor in person onsite. For any questions, please refer to the Minor Policy at [www.SCORE-International.com](http://www.SCORE-International.com), under the SCORE Rule Book

Below are the required steps for a **Co-Driver / Co-Rider / Navigator** to receive wristband(s) in the mail:

1. Team Entry Fees paid in full at the time of request. It is your responsibility to check with your DOR/ROR/Alternate and verify that all fees are paid in full. ☐
2. Co-Driver / Co-Rider / Navigator name must be listed by the DOR/ROR on the race entry form to be listed in any publication or to receive a wristband. Make sure your DOR/ROR or Team Manager has listed you. ☐
3. Must have purchased a 2025 SCORE Membership online.
  - a **NOTE:** Membership is not a race registration, see steps 4 and 5 for complete registration steps.
4. Complete Digital Waiver(s) online. Tutorials and shortcuts for waivers can be found at [www.SCORE-International.com](http://www.SCORE-International.com) > Race Info > Select the logo for the event you're racing, select waiver or tutorial to complete the Race Participant Waiver you need.
5. **Must have completed Co-Driver / Co-Rider / Navigator Required Race Application – 2025 58<sup>th</sup> Baja 1000 form online.** Link to the application: [Co-Driver / Co-Rider / Navigator Application](#). We use this health information to print your wristband. The deadline to complete this form is Oct 24, 2025, at 5 PM for those submitting the request for wristband(s) by mail. ☐
6. **Once you have completed the online Waiver(s), 2025 Membership(s), DOR/ROR/Alternate entry forms, and the Co-Driver, Co-Rider, Navigator Application(s) send an email to [Registration@SCORE-International.com](mailto:Registration@SCORE-International.com) requesting wristbands. Please list all members you would like wristbands for. Only those who show completed online Waiver(s), 2025 Membership(s) DOR/ROR/Alternate entry forms, and the Co-Driver, Co-Rider, Navigator Application(s) will be eligible for wristbands to be mailed. Make sure to provide a mailing address for the bands. Once the email has been received, the following will be done:**
  - a) The DOR/ROR account will be billed \$10.00 for postage. One charge, one mailing per Team.

- b) Once this fee has been paid, the band(s) will be created and mailed out via USPS Priority mail, and a tracking number will be provided to you. Make sure to list all team member(s) wristband(s) requested, we will not mail out multiple sets.
  - c) For the ship to address, use the address you want the wristbands sent to. They will be mailed in **one** envelope.
  - d) If you request a Team Member to pick up your band(s) at onsite Racer Registration, you must advise us in writing. Picture ID will be required.
  - e) NO minor bands will be mailed or provided to any person other than the minor in person onsite. For any questions, please refer to the Minor Policy at [www.SCORE-International.com](http://www.SCORE-International.com), under the SCORE Rule Book
5. A **Controlled Access Waiver** can be completed early, print one from the website, have it signed, attach it to the email requesting the bands. **Limited to 5 bands per team entry.** Any Minor must have a Minor Addendum completed at onsite Registration, parent/guardian must have picture ID. See Controlled Access Policy on our website for restrictions [www.SCORE-International.com](http://www.SCORE-International.com)> Race Info > 58<sup>th</sup> Baja 1000 logo > Controlled Access Policy.

#### Important Notes:

- a) Any person racing in the Stock UTV classes must complete the Digital "**Stock UTV Class Participant Addendum**". In addition to the Race Participant Waiver.
- b) The owner of the vehicle, moto, or quad must be listed on the race application. If the owner is not the Driver of Record, the owner must also fill out a separate Race Participant–Owner waiver.
- c) Anyone withdrawing after bands are mailed must immediately return all bands before a refund request can be initiated.
- d) If you are going to be DOR, ROR, Alternate, Co-Driver, Co-Rider or Navigator in more than one vehicle, moto, or quad you must notate that on the waiver or sign a second waiver.
- e) If any of these steps are not completed, you will not receive your wristband, nor, can it be picked up by a fellow team member; you will have to attend on-site registration, see schedule details above.
