



# Policy for Controlled Access Areas All 2025 SCORE Races Tech/Contingency Inspection & Start/Finish Areas



## Access to Designated Locations

All persons eligible for access to the SCORE designated location(s) must register with SCORE, sign waivers, and receive SCORE issued wristbands. Persons that do not follow SCORE Official directions in these areas will result in persons being denied access and can result in 15-minute penalties to a registered team. Be respectful to all staff and volunteers.

In addition to banded race participants, each team may request wristbands for up to five (5) guests to meet the participants at the bottom of the finish ramp when their vehicle is due to finish or have access to the pits at qualifying. There is no longer access to Tech/Contingency day for these individuals

## Obtaining Wristbands for Guests

To obtain wristbands for guests or team members they do not have to attend registration if they pre-sign the **Controlled Access Area** waiver form. Simply print this waiver form from the SCORE website, (select Race Info > Race logo > Waivers), and have up to five (5) persons sign this form. Bring these signed Controlled Access waiver forms to onsite Registration to obtain bands or send with your request for mailed bands.

All signatures **must be original**; you cannot have anyone sign for others. When you present the waiver form(s) to Registration, if any signature appears to not be original, you will not receive a wristband for that person.

All wristbands must be issued by the close of onsite registration.

## **NO WRISTBANDS WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE FINISH AREA OR AT QUALIFYING**

## Qualifying Access

Qualifying is a restricted area and is not open to the public. Anyone other than banded race participants must have obtained Controlled Access wristbands to enter the area. This includes pit support persons, sponsors, and guests. **For entire Qualifying area, all persons must remain a minimum of 50 feet (15m) away from centerline of qualifying course at all times. Do not stand on outside of any corner on course. No Exceptions!**

## Tech/Contingency Access

Only two banded race participants are allowed in the Tech/Contingency restricted area per team. **No other individuals will be allowed.** Race Participant must go to registration prior to placing your vehicle at the entrance to Tech/Contingency. If your team members do not have correct wristbands for a DOR/ROR, Co-driver/Co-rider at the start of the restricted area, the team will be moved to the side and will not be allowed to enter until correctly banded individuals arrive. All vehicles including moto/quads must be driven through Tech. No pushing or pulling vehicles.

## Start Area on Race Day

All race vehicles must enter the starting area under their own power and starting Driver/Co-Drivers (Navigators), Rider or Co-Riders must be in or on the vehicle, safety equipment secure and be ready to go by the time the vehicle reaches the start day Tech area. Only the race vehicle and persons onboard will be permitted entry into the restricted start area... chase vehicles and additional team members must remain outside the fenced starting area.

### **Finish Area**

Only the banded race participants can be on the interview ramp, all other banded guests and media must stay on the downside of the ramp. If guests enter the ramp, Teams will be penalized with a 15-minute penalty per individual. Media credentials can be suspended for future races.

### **SCORE Team Media**

All registered and approved Team Media must attend onsite Media registration. There will be no SCORE Team Media credential requests accepted at onsite Media Race Registration. You must have registered online before the deadline. There is no Media access to the restricted areas on Tech/Contingency day

### **Review Results with Race Director**

Only the Driver of Record/Rider of Record plus one other team member will be permitted to meet with the Race Director to review results for your entry. See time and location on Schedule of Events

### **Finisher Awards**

Open to guests and the public.
